- Keep your structure and equipment dry when not in use.
- Ideal for protecting furniture, outdoor kitchens, BBQs, smokers, and pizza ovens between uses.
- Maintain an open feel while adding flexibility.
- Walls can roll up out of the way or fitted only when needed, allowing you to enjoy open sides in summer and shelter when conditions change.
- Improve the overall appearance of your space.
- A well-designed cover can make a structure look more finished, intentional, and visually smarter.
- Create a more comfortable space for entertaining.
- Less wind, less damp, and fewer temperature drops help keep gatherings going for longer.



Choosing the right fixing method

We'll always recommend the most suitable fixing method based on how you plan to use your space, your budget, and the location of your structure.

- **Budget and straightforward solutions**

Simple eyeleted hems all round, or a pocket and batten fixing, offer a reliable and cost-effective way to secure covers where ease and practicality are the priority.

- **A neater, more premium finish**

A keder rail along the top combined with turn buttons down the sides creates a cleaner appearance, improved tension, and a smart, long-lasting professional finish. We can add zip doors, windows and even blinds if you want more flexibility.

- **For exposed or windy locations**

Where additional strength is required, we can incorporate an aluminium floor rail system into the bottom to add stability, helping the cover perform reliably in more challenging conditions. Or we can simply just provide you with a pocket to slip a wooden batten into. If you need us to supply the wooden batten, we can do that too. We also supply ground fixings, as required.

Fitting options explained

We offer a small range of proven fixing methods, each suited to different structures, budgets, and locations. We'll always guide you towards the most appropriate option for your setup.

1. Pocket and Batten

Simple and cost-effective

A welded pocket is installed directly into the PVC wall, and a batten slides neatly inside before being fixed to your structure.

- How it's used: Commonly along the top or bottom edge
- Good for: Budget-friendly installs and straightforward DIY fitting
- Flexibility: We can supply the battens, or you can source your own to reduce costs

Why customers choose it:
Simple, reliable, and easy to fit.

"It's a welded pocket in the wall. You slide in a batten and screw it straight to your structure."



Fitting options explained

2. Turn Buttons

Quick-release and practical

Turn buttons are small metal fixings attached to posts or frames. The wall is fitted with eyelets that twist under the button to hold it securely in place.

- *How it's fitted: Screwed into timber or riveted to metal*
- *Where it's used: Typically down the sides of the wall*
- *Good for: Areas where you want to open or remove the wall quickly*

Fast to use, tidy in appearance, and very practical.

"It's like a small metal latch. You twist it to lock or release the wall."



Fitting options explained

3. Keder Rail and Bead

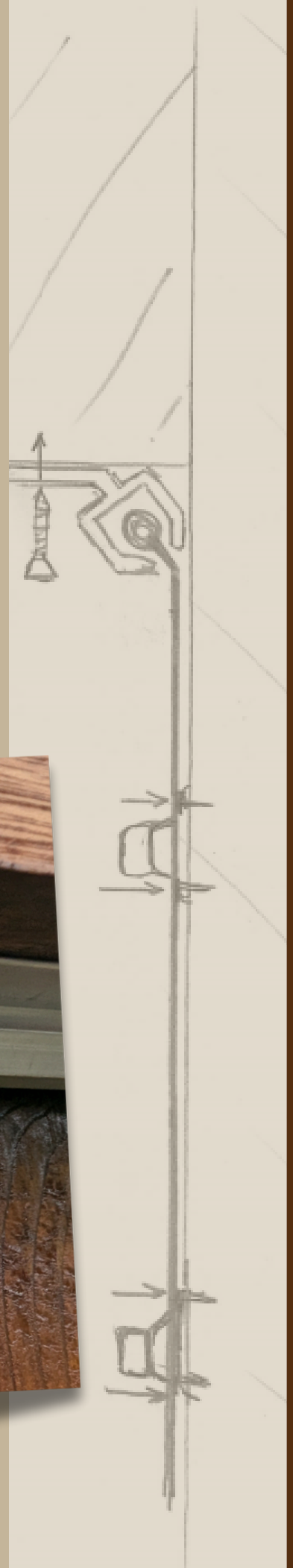
Premium and professional finish

A flexible bead is welded along the edge of the wall, which then slides into an aluminium rail fixed to your structure.

- Where it's used: Most commonly along the top edge
- Finish: Rails can be painted or powder-coated to match your structure
- Good for: A sleek, purpose-built look with added strength

Why customers choose it:
Strong, smart, and built to last.

"The edge of the wall slides into a track. It's very secure and looks purpose-made."



Fitting options explained

4. Floor Rail

Heavy-duty bottom edge

Instead of a timber batten, a slim aluminium rail is inserted into the bottom pocket of the wall, adding weight and rigidity. The rail system is designed and manufactured by us in house and made to measure.

- Where it's used: Along the bottom edge
- Ideal for: Exposed or windy locations

Why customers choose it:

Reduces movement, keeps the wall tight, and improves performance in wind.

"It's a stronger upgrade for the bottom edge, ideal if your area gets a lot of wind."

5. Zip Doors and Windows

Optional extras for access and light

Zips and windows can be intalled directly into the wall, allowing easy access without removing the entire panel. Windows can also include internal roll-down blinds.

- Good for: Regular access and natural light
- Optional: Added only where useful

Convenience and flexibility without compromising protection.

"We can add zips so you can come and go without unclipping the wall."
